Tomorrow's Leaders for Sustainability (TLfS) is a new initiative that helps young people understand and appreciate the key principles and issues of sustainability, while also gaining the knowledge and skills to become leaders in their future careers. The objective is help young people understand the world around them; to learn how to live more sustainably; to improve their skills in leadership, thinking, problem-solving, teamwork and communication; to apply these skills to meaningful sustainability projects; and to act ethically and responsibly.

Tomorrow's Leaders for Sustainability courses have been developed for both secondary and primary schools and are aligned to VELS and the E5 Instructional Model. The TLfS team is now using Guide Beside approaches to train teachers and educators in sustainability to conduct the program in schools.

This workshop will give you the background, pedagogy and resources to run the program yourself, with support from the TLfS team. It will introduce you to the three elements of the program: Educational Activities, Project Activities and Leadership Activities. You will experience practical, learning by doing activities and receive a free copy of a detailed student manual and teacher's notes, plus a copy of both Ollie Saves the Planet and Ollie's Island CD ROMs. Find out about how to become an accredited TLfS facilitator.
